

The Doctrine of Unconditional Election

God chose before the foundation of the world who will be rescued from sin through faith in Christ and be undeservingly saved... and who will not be rescued from continuing in rebellion and thus not be saved, but deservingly perish. God made these choices according to his own purposes apart from any conditions or qualities related to each person

Before we get to our 3 questions...

"How did this make you feel?"

Note: Check out Luke 4:14-28

Q.1: Did God's Word fail?

No!

It is not as though God's word has failed. For not all who are descended from Israel are Israel. Nor because they are Abraham's descendants are they all his children. On the contrary, "Through Isaac your offspring will be reckoned." - Romans 9:6-7

Q.2: Is God unjust?

No!

So it is written: "Jacob I loved, but Esau I hated." What then shall we say? Is God unjust? Certainly not! For He says to Moses: "I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion."

- Romans 9:13-15

What kind of an answer is that?!!

Then Moses said, "Please show me Your glory."

"I will cause all My goodness to pass in front of you," the LORD replied, "and I will proclaim My name the LORD before you.

I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion."- Exodus 33:18-19

What do you think?

Remember Job?


You said, 'Listen now, and I will speak. I will question you, and you shall answer.'
