Chapter 8

1. What does the word minister mean? How is Jesus ministering to us in Heaven?
2. What do the terms like copy, shadow, and pattern indicate about the Old Covenant and priesthood?
3. What were the better promises the author of Hebrews speaks of in 8:10-12?
4. What are the key promises in this passage?
5. Who is making the promises? What is our role in the New Covenant?
