## R12.2 October 2023 Blog The Laymen Ministry

- 1. **Reproducing Ministry** "and what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also." (2 Timothy 2:2)
- 2. Transforming Ministry "I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect." (Romans 12:1-2)
- Scripture-Based Ministry "All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work." (2 Timothy 3:16-17)
- 4. **Discerning Ministry** "Now these Jews were more noble than those in Thessalonica; they received the word with all eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see if these things were so." (Acts 17:11)

It is a privilege and a labor of love to be involved in this ministry. May the Lord continue to use it as a vehicle to further His Kingdom, by the power of His Holy Spirit, in laymen like you.
